

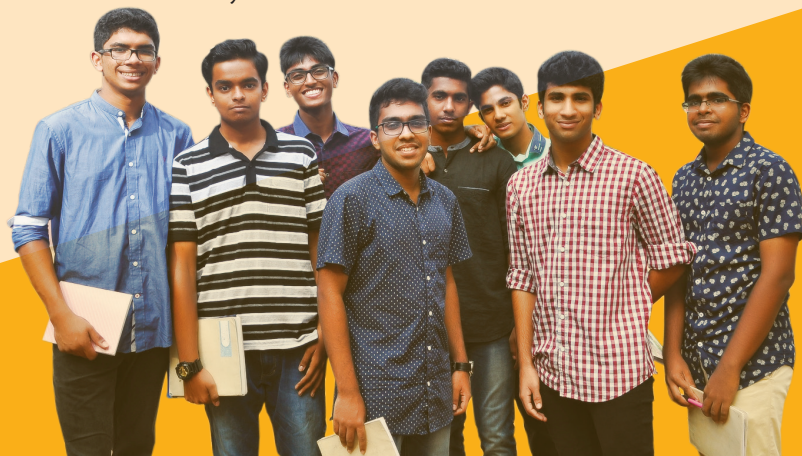


OUTFITS: BOYS & GIRLS

- ⦿ Apart from the school uniform, the following items are to be brought
- ⦿ 4 bathing towels and 6 sets of night suits. (No Lungi is allowed)
- ⦿ 6 sets of colour dress
- ⦿ 1 pair of black shoes
- ⦿ 1 pair of Chappals
- ⦿ One pair of slippers
- ⦿ 1 school tie and 1 school belt. (These items can be bought from the school)
- ⦿ 2.5 X 6 Mattress, one pillow, 3 pillow cases and 3 pairs of bed sheets
- ⦿ Hanger and Mosquito net
- ⦿ 1 pair of games dress and a pair of canvas shoes for games.
- ⦿ Required postal stamps and inland letters.
- ⦿ Other Personal requirements
- ⦿ Soap, soap dish, washing soap, a plastic bucket and a plastic mug.
- ⦿ Comb, shampoo, tooth paste and tooth brush.
- ⦿ Shoe polish and brush.
- ⦿ 2 good locks and a key chain (Duplicate keys are to be deposited with the warden.)
- ⦿ Pen, marker pen, pencil, sharpener, foot rule, eraser, instrument box and colour pencils.

GENERAL RULES

- Mary Mount, being an English medium school, the students are expected to use English as the medium of communication within the campus.
- Every student is expected to maintain the high tone and reputation of the Boarding by excelling out in conduct, good manners and cleanliness both in and out of the campus.
- Boarders can write to their parents or guardians every Sunday. The warden/Asst.warden of the Boarding reserves to himself/herself the right of controlling the correspondence of boarders.
- No one is allowed to leave the campus without prior permission from the warden.
- Students are not allowed to bring valuables such as gold ornaments, cameras, tape recorders, mobile phones, CD, USB, costly watches etc. Students are responsible for the safe custody of their personal belongings.
- Boarders are allowed to use ordinary Mobile Phone twice a week for half an hour to converse with their parents/guardian from 8.30 p.m. to 9.00 p.m. on Wednesdays and Sundays. The phone should not have any extra facilities like Camera, Internet etc.



The same should be handed over to the warden.

- Every student is expected to take part in all the co-curricular activities as part of their civic, cultural and leadership training.
- Boarders should keep strict discipline regarding the rule of language, silence, especially in the dormitory, study halls, bathrooms, etc.
- Boarders should not exchange articles or money with other students and no personal food item is allowed in the Boarding. All money is to be deposited with the warden.
- Books, magazines, periodicals or CD's not approved by the warden are strictly prohibited.
- The use of tobacco, drugs, intoxicants, etc. are strictly forbidden and violation of this will result in immediate dismissal.
- Wanton damage to school property, disfiguring of walls, indecent language or behaviour are punishable offences.
- After night prayer, silence is to be maintained until next day.
- Silence is to be maintained in the dining hall until prayer before meal.
- Use of private electric/electronic appliances is forbidden.
- Good conduct from all students both inside and outside the Boarding is strictly demanded. Bad behaviour, lack of respect to the authorities, indiscipline, repeated late coming, interference with the privacy of others, disobedience of rules of the Boarding are reasons enough for one to be dismissed from the Boarding.
- Loyalty to the Boarding is expected from the students and when they are aware of any such happening affecting the prestige of the Boarding or any of the students in the Boarding; they are bound to inform the warden of all such happenings for their safety and security.
- Boarding authorities have the right to take disciplinary action against any inmate if and when found offendable against the Boarding regulations.
- Mary Mount Boarding is a home away from home. Students are most welcome to meet the Principal or Warden to explain individual problems or difficulties, if any.
- Admission to boarding is for the whole academic year - so no student is allowed to leave in between without paying the full amount for the whole year

BOARDING

Mary Mount Public School & Junior College, Kattachira is the first educational venture of the Mary Mount Convent which belongs to the congregation of Little Workers of the Sacred Hearts. The school was established in June 1999.

The School is named after Mother Mary who guided the life of Jesus of Nazareth. Under her watchful eyes, Jesus grew both in body and in wisdom, gaining favour with God and men. The aim of education is total human development. Every child that passes through the shade of this citadel of formation is guided to comprehensive development, bringing all the talents and aptitudes to full maturity. Keeping this aim as priority, the school offers a wide range of facilities and programmes to the students. The syllabus is tuned according to the CBSE system.

Mary Mount Boarding is a residence for the students of Mary Mount Public School & Junior College, Kattachira. This boarding aims at providing a homely atmosphere where a happy, friendly and spiritual relationship is fostered and maintained.

ADMISSION

- Application form for admission to the Boarding can be collected from the Office.
- Only Mary Mount Public School & Junior College students are admitted to Mary Mount Boarding.
- Dismissal or withdrawal from the school, automatically affects the place in the Boarding.
- The warden will be in charge of the management and day to day administration of the Boarding.
- In matters of admission, accommodation and disciplinary action, the Principal's ruling shall be final.



AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

Mary Mount aims at helping the youth to develop into upright, creative, confident and competent citizens who are imbued with love and concern for others, with spiritual sensitivity and personal freedom, so as to earn a living and to contribute to the economic and social progress of the nation.

The Mary Mount system of education has the specific objective of forming men and women to believe and trust in the Fatherhood of God, the brotherhood and sisterhood of human beings and to promote the integrity of creation. Equality, Fraternity, Justice, Freedom and Respect for the basic human dignity becomes the primary and specific objective of the System.

Our's is a value based education system, aiming at the all round development of the child. The boarding life here helps the child to imbibe all the spiritual and moral virtues.



VISITORS AND PHONE CALLS

- ▶ Relatives and friends of students are not allowed to visit them during school hours
- ▶ Parents are requested not to disturb the regular rhythm of boarding by their frequent visits and phone calls.
- ▶ If there is any need to meet your children, you may do so only on 4th Sunday between 1.30 and 4.00 pm. Whenever such visits are to be made you are expected to get prior permission from the warden.
- ▶ Boarders are permitted to take leave only for the family programmes related to their father, mother, sisters, brothers and grandparents.
- ▶ Telephone calls can be done from 8.30 p.m. to 9.00 p.m. on Wednesdays and Sundays.
- ▶ On Second Saturdays, Onam and X'mas holidays, boarders are permitted to be taken home by their parents or guardians with the permission of the warden.
- ▶ Those students who go home for holidays are to be back by the eve of the next working day, before 5 p.m

DISCIPLINE

Every boarder shall maintain the highest moral standards of life at all places. Rules of modesty and decorum in dress must be strictly adhered to.

All cases of illness must be immediately reported to the warden. In case of serious illness the parent/guardian must take charge of their ward.

An inmate who wishes to vacate the Boarding must give a written notice two weeks in advance, signed by his/her parent/guardian and it is compulsory to pay the full fee.
